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WATER IS **LIFE**

Water is Life and soon it may be more precious than **Gold**

Water is an essential element of life, we all need it not only to drink, but it also plays an important role in economic growth. The presence of water resources, or rather lack of them, can also be the cause of geopolitical conflicts. As human demand for water increases water scarcity becomes apparent in very different ways.

Water Management

Current & Future Challenges

Water distinguishes our planet compared to all the others we know about. While the global supply of available freshwater is more than adequate to meet all current and foreseeable water demands, its spatial and temporal distributions are not. There are many regions where our freshwater resources are inadequate to meet domestic, economic development, and environmental needs. In such regions, the lack of adequate clean water to meet the human drinking water and sanitation needs is indeed a constraint on human health and productivity and hence on economic development as well as on the maintenance of a clean environment and healthy ecosystems. All of us involved in research must find ways to remove these constraints. We face multiple challenges in doing that, especially given a changing and uncertain future climate, and a rapidly growing population that is driving increased social and economic development, globalization, and urbanization. How best to meet these challenges requires research in all aspects of water management.

Addressing Water Management Constraints to Achieve Prosperity

Within a couple of decades, water scarcity may affect about two-thirds of the world's population. In many countries, there is still a tendency to deal with water scarcity problems by augmenting the water supply, e.g., by increasing surface and groundwater storage and allocation through the creation of new infrastructure, desalination of salt water, or brackish water, reuse of wastewater, or recharging aquifers. This tendency has prevailed over-focusing on reducing water demand, e.g., by stemming the losses in transport and distribution systems, implementing adequate tariff systems, which seek to encourage lower water demand levels, changing water use technologies, and, generally, increasing the efficiency of water use in domestic, industrial, and irrigation systems; in other words, seeking to increase overall water productivity.

The challenge to water managers is even greater when dealing with transboundary water bodies, especially international ones. Transboundary rivers and aquifers are common features of today's hydrologic and political landscape. Within different countries and groups of countries that share an aquifer or river, it is vastly beneficial to come to an agreement on how to share the water in times of stress before that stress occurs rather than to work out such agreements during times of stress. The water in transboundary rivers and aquifers is a resource whose management requires institutions that cross traditional political borders.

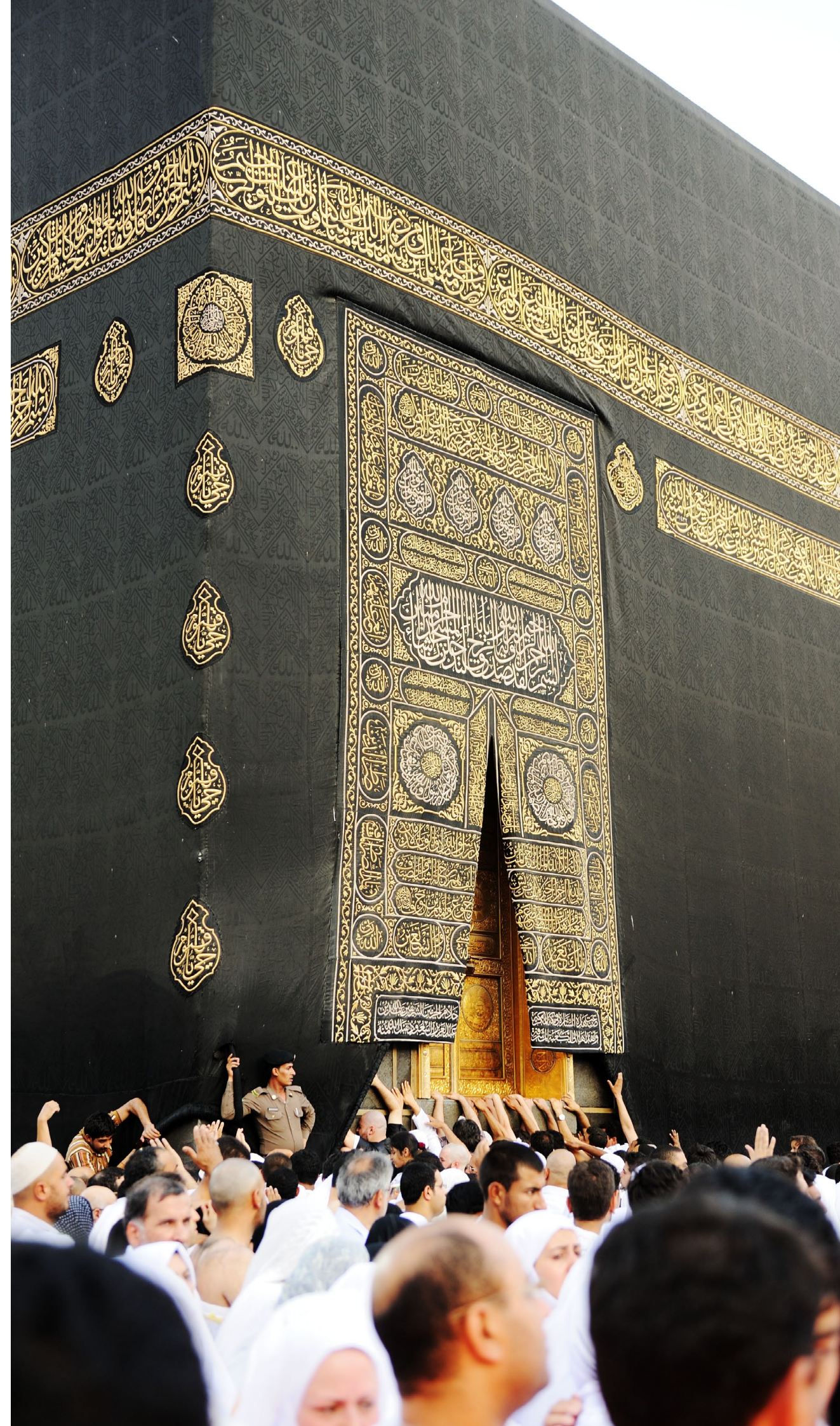
HAJJ & ADHA FEAST

Why Hajj dey important for Muslims

Hajj 2021

will begin in the evening of Saturday, July 17 and ends in the evening of Thursday, July 22

The Hajj is an annual Islamic pilgrimage to Mecca, Saudi Arabia, the holiest city for Muslims. Hajj is a mandatory religious duty for Muslims that must be carried out at least once in their lifetime by all adult Muslims who are physically and financially capable of undertaking the journey, and of supporting their family during their absence from home.

In Islamic terminology, Hajj is a pilgrimage made to the Kaaba, the “House of God”, in the sacred city of Mecca in Saudi Arabia. It is one of the Five Pillars of Islam, alongside Shahadah, Salat, Zakat, and Sawm. The Hajj is a demonstration of the solidarity of the Muslim people, and their submission to God (Allah). The word Hajj means “to attend a journey”, which connotes both the outward act of a journey and the inward act of intentions.

The rites of pilgrimage are performed over five to six days, extending from the 8th to the 12th or 13th of Dhu al-Hijjah, the last month of the Islamic calendar. Because the Islamic calendar is lunar and the Islamic year is about eleven days shorter than the Gregorian year, the Gregorian date of Hajj changes from year to year.

The Hajj is associated with the life of the Islamic prophet Muhammad from the 7th century AD, but the ritual of pilgrimage to Mecca is considered by Muslims to stretch back thousands of years to the time of Abraham. During Hajj, pilgrims join processions of millions of people, who simultaneously converge on Mecca for the week of the Hajj, and perform a series of rituals: each person walks counter-clockwise seven times around the Kaaba (a cube-shaped building and the direction of prayer for Muslims), trots (walks briskly) back and forth between the hills of Safa and Marwah seven times, then drinks from the Zamzam Well, goes to the plains of Mount Arafat to stand in vigil, spends a night in the plain of Muzdalifa, and performs symbolic stoning of the devil by throwing stones at three pillars. After the sacrifice of an animal (which can be accomplished by using a voucher, the Pilgrims then are required to either shave or trim their heads (male) or trim the ends of their hair (female). A celebration of the three-day global festival of Eid al-Adha proceeds thereafter.

In 2020 & 2021, while not canceling the Hajj outright, the Saudi Government announced that they would only welcome “very limited numbers” of pilgrims who are residents of Saudi Arabia due to the global COVID-19 pandemic.

EASY & HEALTHY RECIPES

Lemon Chicken

you can cook in 30 minutes

A luscious, tangy stir-fry that makes two generous portions for very few calories.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 tsp cornflour
- 1 tsp dark soy sauce
- Finely grated zest & juice 1/2 small lemon
- 2 tsp coconut or canola oil
- 1 skinless chicken breast fillet, cut into 1.5cm slices
- 1 capsicum, any color, deseeded and sliced
- 1 medium carrot, trimmed and thinly sliced
- 100g broccoli, cut into small florets
- 150ml chicken stock
- 4 spring onions, trimmed and thickly sliced

1. Mix the cornflour with the soy sauce and lemon juice in a small bowl.
2. Heat the oil in a large frying pan or wok over high heat, add the chicken, capsicum, carrot, and broccoli, and stir-fry for 2–3 minutes, or until the chicken is lightly browned and the vegetables are beginning to soften.
3. Pour the lemon and soy mixture into the pan, add the chicken stock and spring onions, and bring to a simmer. Reduce the heat and cook for 2 minutes, or until the sauce is slightly thickened and the chicken is cooked through, stirring regularly.
4. Sprinkle with grated lemon zest and serve with rice.



Strawberry Frozen Yogurt

This refreshing frozen yogurt lighter than traditional ice cream

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 c. plain 2-percent reduced-fat Greek-style yogurt
- 1 c. sugar, divided
- 1/3 c. light syrup
- 1 1/2 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/4 tsp. kosher salt
- 2 c. fresh strawberries

Whisk together yogurt, half-and-half, 2/3 cup sugar, corn syrup, vanilla, and salt; let stand 5 minutes. Whisk until sugar dissolves. Chill for 2 hours or until very cold. Meanwhile, cook fresh strawberries, and 1/3 cup sugar over medium heat for 6 to 8 minutes or until the fruit is softened and begins to break down; cool completely. Swirl strawberry mixture into prepared yogurt. Pour mixture into the bowl of an electric ice-cream maker, and process according to manufacturer's instructions. Freeze 1 hour before serving. Store up to 1 week.



EGYPT BUSINESS

Sisi ratifies law linking state's general budget for the fiscal year 2021/22

CAIRO – 4 July 2021: President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi ratified Law No. 74 of 2021 linking the state's general budget for the fiscal year 2021-2022.

The first article of the law stipulates that the uses of the state's general budget for the fiscal year 2021-2022 are estimated at LE 2.461 trillion.

The law was published in the Official Gazette in its Sunday issue.

The total resources of the state's general budget amount to LE 2.461 trillion, divided into LE 2 trillion for the state's administrative apparatus, and LE 185.953 billion for the local administration, according to an earlier statement of Finance Minister Mohamed Maait. He pointed out that the expected state budget expenditures amounted to LE 1.837 trillion. Spending on Health will hike 16 percent to LE 108.8 billion while spending on education will increase 10 percent to LE 172.6 billion, marking the largest spending increases. On the other hand, spending on social protection programs will reach LE 283 billion, down from LE 286 billion in 2020/2021.

According to the announced date, the size of the wages and compensation section for state workers reached LE 362 billion, including LE 171.213 billion for the state's administrative apparatus and LE 142.320 billion for the local administration.

Maait explained that the allocations of the special allowance amounted to LE 2.762 billion and the grant allocations reached LE 340

million, while the allocations of the fourth chapter of the state budget projections for the fiscal year 2021/2022 (subsidies, grants, and social benefits) amounted to about LE 321.301 billion, of which about LE 183.329 billion are allocated for subsidies.

The draft state budget for the fiscal year 2021/2022 includes allocating about LE 164.246 billion, for social benefits, of which about LE 19 billion is for social security pension allocations, and LE 70 million is for child pension allocations. The volume of social assistance amounted to about LE 135.006 billion, of which 134.998 billion is contributions to pension funds and LE 8.032 million in social assistance in kind.

The total amount of budget grants from foreign governments amounted to LE 85.422 billion, grants from foreign organizations. He explained that in light of the repercussions of the spread of the coronavirus epidemic, it is intended that the growth rate of the gross domestic product (GDP) during the fiscal year 2021/2021 will increase to 5.4 percent (according to the estimates of the Ministry of Planning and Economic Development, which was used when preparing the budget) compared to an expected growth rate of 2.8 percent during the fiscal year of 2020/2021. The government will support the efforts of the Central Bank of Egypt (CBE) to reduce annual inflation rates to reach low annual rates estimated at about 7 percent, in accordance with the announced and published inflation targets of the CBE.
